____ SCHOOL COLLABORATIVE PROJECTS/TOUR PERFORMANCES. BCT works closely with school faculty and staff members to design and implement a wide range of theatre opportunities for students, from a single workshop or performance to a longterm "Page to Stage" playwriting and production residency project.

____ SCHOOL CHORUS PROJECT. School vocal music teachers are invited to work with BCT staff to enable students to participate as chorus members in a mainstage production. Commitment includes several weeks of rehearsals during the school day, plus final dress rehearsals in the theatre, and some or all of the public performances.

____ PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT. BCT artistic staff offers workshops with training, practice, and planning components to enable teachers to utilize playwriting and theatre across the curriculum and create projects to achieve curriculum goals for their students. BOSTON CHILDREN'S THEATRE is on the MCC Roster of Creative Teaching Partners and an approved PDP provider.
